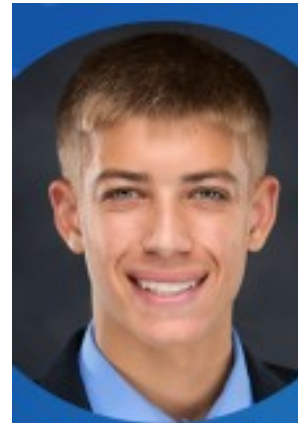
January 2018 | Kendyl Bagley | Clinton High School DECA

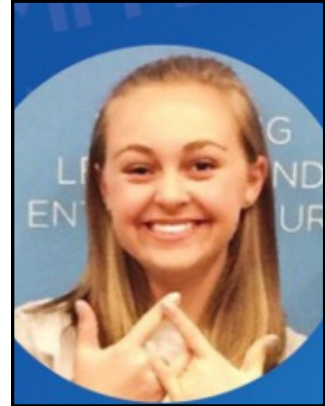
November 2017 | Ashely Wells | Westosha High School DECA
